1. Applicants must provide the following
  - a. Completed application.
  - b. High school transcript.
  - c. Option of expression.
  - d. Two letters of recommendation by outstanding members of the community.
2. All applications are due on **April 6, 2018** and will be selected from the Brazos Valley. Applications can be mailed to the BVAAM.
3. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select a winner who will receive \$1000. (\$500 each semester).

### **2018 Brazos Valley Scholarship Guidelines**

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a *Brazos Valley* Senior High School.
2. The application is due April 6, 2018 at the Brazos Valley African American Museum 500 E Pruitt St, Bryan, TX.
3. The applicant must submit an official High School Transcript which includes grade point average, class rank, and anticipated date of graduation.
4. Application must include one letter of recommendation from either a teacher, community member, counselor or spiritual mentor.
5. Each applicant should provide evidence of extra-curricular activities, community activities, honors and awards.
6. Applicant may express any financial need in the application.
7. Scholarship recipients must provide proof of acceptance to a college/university (include any financial scholarships)
8. Scholarships will be awarded to the successful applicants.
9. Applicant has a choice to complete one of the following options:
  - 2 written essays, or
  - Various poetic pieces, or
  - Video presentation and answers one of the following questions:

*B. What events in your life have helped you become a successful student?*
